Rosedale Technical College anticipates the ability to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants in the near future to our students who are actively enrolled. The grants are based on funding from the U.S. Department of Education and will be used to offset expenses related to the students cost of attendance at the institution. The Department of Education understands that student's ability to pay for these expenses has been impacted by the pandemic. Relevant expenses are such things as housing, food, course materials and supplies, health care, child care and tuition. Rosedale Technical College's Administration will use the information you provide in the enclosed application to determine your eligibility for a grant and the amount you may be eligible for. Grants awarded will go directly to the student in the form of one or more checks. Students may choose to apply the grant towards any unmet financial need they have resulting in tuition balance. In order to be considered for a grant and the first round of disbursements, please return your application by March 10th to Rosedale Financial Aid Director, Kim Bell.

Please make sure to fill it out completely and provide your most recent contact information as not to delay the process. Checks will be mailed so we will need your most current address. Even if you check "NO" to indicate you have not been impacted, please return the application for our records and to maintain eligibility in the event your circumstances change. Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Report Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Rosedale Technical College (OPE ID 012050) received stabilization funds under Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act. This fund applies to the student portion received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II) that is designed exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

Rosedale Technical College appreciates that Congress and the President have made these critical funds available for eligible students have who expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus pandemic. Rosedale takes receipt of these funds seriously and is distributing the funds in accordance with the CRRSA Act and implementing guidelines.

Rosedale Technical College is providing the information below for transparency purposes and to be in compliance with the Department of Education's directive on reporting of these funds. - The institution has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement for the Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students. The institution has used, or intends to use no less than 50% of the funds received under The CRRSA Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
- 2. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students is \$ 421,247
- 3. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants distributed to students as the date of this fund report is \$292,225
- 4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, and thus eligible to receive emergency financial aid grants under CRRSA Act, as of the date of this report is 339.

Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds Emergency Financial Aid Grant calculation policy

Rosedale Technical Colleges grant calculation below was developed in accordance with guidelines set forth by the Department of Education for the disbursement of emergency financial aid grants provided through the student portion of Higher Education Emergency Relief Act.

Rosedale Technical College identified students who were eligible for Title IV funds and were active students as of March 10, 2021. Students were provided a grant application to request funding and indicate to the school the impact of the disruption of campus operations as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic. The institution also identified a student's EFC and dependency status based on their 2020-2021 FAFSA to be considered in the calculation formula. The factors listed below along with the corresponding dollar amount were used to calculate emergency financial aid relief grants to students.
