

Statement of Policy: Education Programs to Promote Awareness of Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, Sexual Assault, and Stalking

Rosedale Technical College educates the incoming students and employee community about sexual violence, violence prevention, and all relevant Rosedale Technical College policies and procedures during all orientations held for students at the onset of a class or employment. Current students and employees receive training at least annually.

In addition, Rosedale Technical College conducts new and current employee training on these topics at least annually. The Title IX Coordinator is responsible for training all Rosedale current students and employees about Rosedale Technical College's policies regarding sexual violence and for conducting new student and employee training.

The new and current employee and student training sessions include:

- A statement that Rosedale Technical College prohibits crimes of dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault, and stalking
- The definition of those crimes under federal and state law
- The definition of consent, in reference to sexual activity, if available under state law
- A description of safe and positive options for bystander intervention
- Information on risk reduction
- Information contained in Rosedale Technical College's policies and procedures related to preventing, reporting, and responding to sexual offenses, including disciplinary procedures and victim rights
- A description of Rosedale Technical College's ongoing prevention and awareness campaigns for students and employees.
