- ✓ **Official High School Transcript (Translated & Evaluated)** required.
 - This process takes several weeks - **Rosedale Tech must receive it before classes begin.**

- ✓ **English Proficiency** required (reading, writing, understanding, & speaking) - All coursework and instruction is provided in English.



Financial Aid

- ✗ **Most International Students are NOT eligible for FAFSA** (U.S. Federal Student Aid)
- ✓ **Eligible Non-Citizens** may qualify if they meet specific immigration criteria, such as:
 1. **U.S. National or Permanent Resident:**
 - U.S. National (includes natives of American Samoa or Swains Island)
 - U.S. Permanent Resident with a Form I-551 or I-151 (Green Card)
 2. **Arrival-Departure Record (I-94) from USCIS showing one of the following:**

- Refugee
- Asylum Granted
- Conditional Permanent Resident
- Cuban-Haitian Entrant
- Conditional Entrant (valid only if issued before April 1, 1980)
- Parolee (must be paroled for at least one year and provide USCIS evidence of intent to become a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident)

- **Modified parole requirements apply to:**

1. Ukrainian citizens paroled into the U.S. between February 24, 2022 and September 20, 2024
2. Afghan citizens paroled into the U.S. between July 31, 2021 and September 30, 2023

3. T non-immigrant status (T-Visa) holders (for victims of human trafficking) or children of a T-1 non-immigrant status holder.

4. Battered Immigrant-Qualified Alien status under the Violence Against Women Act.

5. Citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Republic of Palau:

- Eligible for Federal Pell Grants, Federal Supplemental Education Opportunity Grants, and Federal Work-Study.

⊘ NOT Eligible for Federal Aid:

- Hold only a “Notice of Approval to Apply for Permanent Resident” (I-171 or I-464)
- Hold only an Employment Authorization Document (Form I-766)
- Are in the U.S. on an F-1, F-2, or M-1 Student Visa
- Are in the U.S. on a J-1 or J-2 Exchange Visitor Visa
- Hold a G-Series Visa (pertaining to international organizations)

📄 Expired Documents

- If your Green Card is expired, it does not necessarily mean your status as a legal permanent resident has expired. You may need to apply for a renewal promptly.
